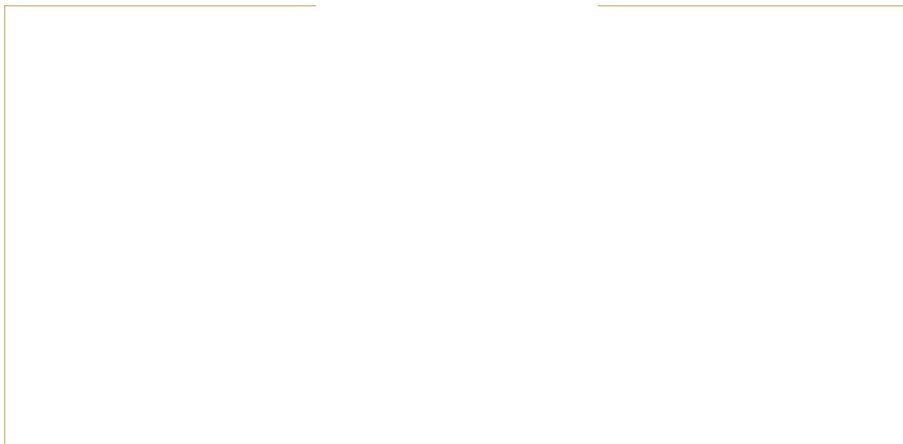


This accounting area of emphasis is designed to prepare students for careers in accounting, general and financial management, financial analysis, taxation, auditing, and accounting information systems.

Upon graduation, you will have two initial placement options upon graduation, beginning your career in corporate accounting, or earning your Certified Public Accountant (CPA) certification for public accounting.

This program requires extra coursework to get to 120 credits – students have the option to go for a 4-year Master's program.

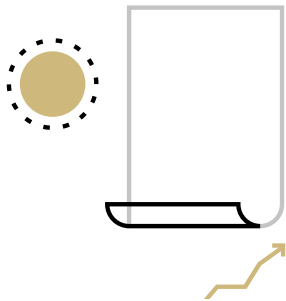
